

Philipp Groth (b. 1993, Germany), lives and works in Chicago, IL and Berlin. He graduated from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago in 2023 (MFA) and from The University of the Arts London in 2021 (MA).

Groth recently exhibited his work at König Galerie Tokio (Tokyo, Japan), Chicago Sculpture International, König Galerie Berlin, Co-Prosperity Gallery (Chicago, IL), CON Gallery (Tokyo, Japan), MANA Contemporary (Chicago, IL), Gasbon Metabolism (Hokuto, Japan), Kanya&Kage (Berlin, Germany), Tribeca Film Center (New York City, NY), and A4 Chengdu (Sichuan, China) among others.

His work has been supported by grants and fellowships from The School of the Art Institute of Chicago, Ox-Bow School of the Arts, and the A4 Museum Chengdu. From 2018 to 2022, he taught at the University of Applied Sciences SRH in Berlin.

Following his graduation, he was named a LeRoy Neiman Fellow in 2023. Currently, he holds the position of artist in residence at the A4 Art Museum in Chengdu, China.
